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HS registration will be taking place on August 13 and 14. I have talked with Mrs. Brown and Band students may register either on the 14th or before the Band meets at 10:30 on the 15th.

Each section is expected to perform a skit for the talent show. Section leaders should be thinking about ideas for your sections’ performance. We also encourage additional performances by individuals or other groups (for example seniors...). We want to get away from “improvised” performances. Try to plan ahead a bit more than we did last year.

Evening Rehearsal (6:00 – 8:00 pm) - We will have one Wednesday evening rehearsal on August 22 so that we will be prepared for our first home game on August 23. This rehearsal is expected of all members of the Marching Band. Percussion will be expected to attend additional weekly rehearsals. These rehearsals will be scheduled during the first week of school.

Football Playoffs: The Flying G's frequently qualify for the football playoffs. Should this occur again this season, the playoff games would begin on the Friday or Saturday after the last regular season game. The band will perform at these games and all students will be expected to attend.

Band Camp Rules & Regulations

1. All campers and counselors are expected to attend all scheduled activities.
2. Campers may not leave the grounds without consent of the band director.
3. Visitors will not be allowed on the camp grounds.
4. Equipment may not be moved from one area or facility to another without permission of the camp director.
5. Food and drinks are not permitted in the rehearsal hall or cabins.
6. Fireworks or firearms are not permitted.
7. Smoking, drugs or alcohol are not permitted.
8. Curfews and lights out policies will be strictly enforced.
9. Hazing will not be permitted.
10. All injuries must be reported immediately to the director.
11. There will be no visitation in rooms between campers of the opposite sex.
12. Musical instruments should not be played in the camper's rooms at any time.
13. Rooms will be inspected by the director and/or camp counselors every day after breakfast.
14. Dress at outdoor activities will follow the school dress code. This means appropriate length for shorts, no tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts. All clothing should be suitable for long hours in the sun. Low-cut and see through garments are not permitted. Shirts and tennis shoes (no sandals or flip flops) must be worn at all times. Hats and Sunscreen are strongly recommended.
15. Campers are expected to wear undergarments.
16. The director is authorized to make additional rules when necessary.
